Weekly Themes

Week 1: Robots June 6 - 10

Come and learn the nuts and bolts of robots! Build your own robot out of a tin can, make your very own robot vest or helmet, and explore the ways that these wonderful machines help us in our daily lives.

Week 2: Pitching a Tent June 13 - 17

Come and explore the world of camping with your friends at Woods Creek Montessori. Make a tent out of sheets, find your way with flashlights, gobble up s'mores on a stick, and create fun campfire art.

Week 3: Dog Days of Summer June 20 - 24

Join us for a "pawsome" week learning all about our favorite family friend! We will talk about different dog breeds, look at pictures of our dogs from home, explore the responsibility of taking care of a dog, and investigate special jobs for dogs.



Week 4: Artful Antics June 27 - July 1

It's time to exercise your imagination! This week will challenge and inspire campers to design their own masterpieces through drawing, painting, ceramics, and mixed media. Please bring your creativity!

Week 5: Happy Birthday, USA! July 5 - 8

Join us for a star-spangled celebration of our nation's birthday. We will be sharing the ways we celebrate this holiday with stars and stripes, as well as tall tales and traditions. Campers will march in their own parade, and set off balloon fireworks. **No camp on July 4, tuition will be prorated.*

Week 6: Symphony of the Senses July 11 - 15

Awaken your five senses through creative, hands-on activities. Campers will see, touch, smell, hear and taste the world around them through experiments, arts and crafts, snacks, and games.

Week 7: Pop! Bang! Fizz! July 18 - 22

One of our favorite weeks of camp, our days will be filled with asking questions and finding answers. We will use kitchen chemistry and backyard physics to create experiments that demonstrate the wonder of scientific discovery.

Week 8: Space Academy July 25 - 29

Can a star turn into a planet? What makes space so cold? Why does the moon get bigger when it's closer to the horizon? Where is the edge of the universe? This week we will learn about space, space travel, and our solar system. Campers make flashlight constellation projectors, create intergalactic slime, and launch a fizzy rocket. This week will be out of this world!

Week 9: Tell Me A Story August 1 - 5

Everyone has a story to tell! Come explore the art of storytelling through the written word, performance, photography, and illustrations. This will be a week full of stories of all kinds. Older campers will have an opportunity to author and publish their own work.
